REVISED RULES FOR THE AWARD OF MERIT-CUM-MEANS
SCHOLARSHIPS BY THE GOVERNMENT OF RAJASTHAN TO
RAJSTHANI STUDENTS STUDYING IN SAINIK SCHOOL
CHITTORGARH

In super session of all previous orders/amendments issued by this department vide No. F.15(30)/Edu/Cell-VI/61 dated 16 Jun 1962 , 09 Jan 1963 , 11 Feb 1963 , 24 Nov 64 and 28 Apr 1965, the Governor has been pleased to accord approval to the following Revised Rules and Regulations for the grant of financial assistance in the form of scholarships to the students belonging to Rajasthan and studying in Sainik School, Chittorgarh :-

1) Titles

These rules will be called Revised Rules for the award of Merit-cum-Means scholarship to Rajasthani students studying at Sainik School, Chittorgarh.

2) Allocation of scholarships

“The State Government will award new scholarships every year to the Rajasthani Students qualified in the All India Entrance Examination, conducted by the Board of Governors Sainik Schools Society for admission to Sainik Schools as per the “Means” of their parents/ Guardians.”

3) Eligibility of Candidates for the award of scholarships

A students shall be deemed to belong to Rajasthan if he satisfies any of the following conditions :-

- i) Born in Rajasthan, Parents being bonafide residents of this state ; or
- ii) Whether he or his parents have a house in Rajasthan for 10 or more years and that if they have a house elsewhere also they adopt Rajasthan as the Home state or ;
- iii) He or his parents have been living in a rented house for 10 years or moral Lease Deed may be produced to established this.

4) Value of Scholarships

The value of scholarships for the various income groups of parents/guardians will be as Follows :-

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| (a) | Scholarship equal to full amount of fee plus clothing charges. | Average total monthly income of Rs.10000/- or less. |
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- (b) Scholarship equal to three-fourth ($3/4^{\text{th}}$) amount of fee and three fourth amount of clothing charges. Average total monthly income from Rs.10001/- to 15000/-
- (c) Scholarship equal to half ($1/2$) amount of fee and half amount of the total clothing charges. Average total monthly income from Rs.15001/- to 20000/-
- (d) Scholarship equal to one-fourth ($1/4^{\text{th}}$) amount of fee and one fourth amount clothing charges. Average total monthly income from Rs.20001/- to 25000/-

The fees of the school will be as under :-

5. Method of selection for Award of Scholarships.

(a) Scholarships will be awarded to candidates on the basis of their merit in the All India Entrance Examination conducted by the Board of Governors, Sainik Schools Society.

(b) Amount of scholarship will be determined on the basis of total average monthly income of parents/guardians of a students and as indicated in para 4 above, the type of scholarship to be awarded will be tentative till the income of the parents/guardian is finally verified and accepted.

6. Defination of Income.

Monthly income of both the parents i.e. father and mother or guardian in case the parents are not alive, means the gross earnings from self employment in the form of pay, special pay, personal pay, deputation pay, allowance and honoratia, overtime allowance, pension etc and or in the form of rent from property, interest from securities, shares dividends, money lending, profits from business, trade, agriculture, farming, profession and vocation etc.

The following will, however, be excluded from the total income :-

- (a) House Rent allowance
- (b) Travelling allowance
- (c) Conveyance allowance granted on the condition on maintaining conveyance.
- (d) Messing allowance.
- (e) Washing allowance
- (f) Compensatory allowance etc.

7. Verification of Income

(a) On finalization of the merit list, Principal, Sainik School, Chittorgarh in accordance with the Revised Rules of Scholarships of the Governments of Rajasthan, will inform the parents/guardians of merit holders that their son(s) is/are likely to be awarded full/three-fourth/half/quarter scholarships based on their income mentioned in the application form and subject to the production of their income certificate/affidavits to the satisfaction of the Government of Rajasthan. The income affidavits will be on a non-judicial stamped paper worth rupees ten and countersigned by an executive Magistrate/Sub Divisional Magistrate. These will also be scrutinized/verified by the Collector of their (Permanent residence) district. Parents are also required to submit a certified copy of their annual income tax return of the proceeding year filed with the Income Tax authorities. In case of non-income tax payers they are required to submit an affidavit to this effect that they are not paying income tax.

(b) Government and non-Government salaried parents/guardians are required to furnish a detailed certificate of their total monthly income (including allowances) duly attached by their Heads of Departments/Employers. They are also to furnish an affidavit of their average total monthly income on a non-judicial stamped paper worth rupees 10/- (a specimen of the income certificate/affidavit is attached as Annexure -1)

(c) All other parent/guardians (non –salaried class vis businessman, Agriculturists etc) will submit their affidavits of their average total monthly income on a non-judicial stamped paper worth rupees ten. (a specimen of the income certificate/affidavit is attached as Annexure 2-3).

The income from agricultural land will be determined as under :-

Agriculture land holding with agriculturist.	Yearly income to be determined.
1. Income from irrigated land	Rs.1000/- per acre
2. Income from un-irrigated land (in Kota, Ajmer & Udaipur divisions)	Rs.200/- per acre
3. Income from un-irrigated land (in Jodhpur & Bikaner divisions)	Rs.80/- per acre

(d) Income certificate and affidavit and affidavits from a guardian will be accepted only when both the parents of the boy are not alive.

(e) The income certificates/affidavits received from the parents of the boys will be scrutinized/verified by the Collector of the district or any officer authorized by him.

(f) The award of new scholarships and renewal of scholarships to Rajasthani boys will be scrutinized by a Committee consisting of the following:-

- (1) The Collector, Chittorgarh - Chairman
- (2) Deputy Secretary to Govt of Rajasthan
- (3) Accounts Officer, Education Deptt Govt of Rajasthan.
- (4) Inspector of Schools, Chittorgarh
- (5) Principal, Sainik School, Chittorgarh (Secretary)

The committee will assemble at Sainik School, Chittorgarh at a date to be notified by the Principal.

(g) After scrutinizing the award of scholarship the claim will be submitted to Education Department for release of scholarship claim.

8. Terms and conditions of the award.

(a) The scholarships will be awarded to new entrants from the date of their joining the Sainik Schools.

(b) The scholarship will be awarded every year on the basis of the income of the parents provided the scholar's annual progress is reported satisfactory by the Principal of the Institution. The existing scholarships will also be renewal every year on the basis of the income.

(c) A students who passes the annual examination in second attempt or at the supplementary or compartmental examination will not be eligible to the award of scholarship in the following year. Hard and deserving cases may however, be considered by Govt on the recommendation of the Principal.

(d) Deterioration in the scholars tic work or misbehavior on the part of the scholarship holder may result in cancellation in part or in whole, temporarily or permanently of the scholarship.

(e) If a scholarship holder discontinuous his studies before completing his higher secondary education at the Sainik School without may valid reason or be expoiled from the school for any misbehavior shall be required to refund the entire amount of scholarship received by him.

(f) If after the award of scholarship, the income affidavit or other particulars such as domicile, date of birth of the boy etc, are found incorrect of false, the boy will be expoiled from the school and the parents/guardians shall be required to refund the entire amount of scholarship received by the boy in one lumpsum. In case he fails to repay, the whole amount can be recovered from him as arrears of land revenue under PDR Act or may other law in force and/or other penalty as may imposed by the Government.

(g) the parents/guardians of the recipient of the scholarship will be required to execute a band to the effect that if their boy does not take all competitive examinations of the Union Public Service Commission for admission to the National Defence Academy for which he is eligible or having taken the examination does not enter the National Defence Academy, if selected, he will have to refund the State Government the value of total scholarship availed by him son/ward during his stay in the school. Similarly, if he leaves the school at any intermediate stage without taking the available examination of the Union Public Service Commission, he will have to refund the value of total scholarship received by him during his stay at the school.

(h) Conversion of scholarship from one category to another shall not be permitted.

9. Mode of Payment

The total amount of 'renewal and fresh' scholarship will be sanctioned to the Principal, Sainik School Chittorgarh in lumpsum on receipt of the claim from him.
